



# Be Responsive — Be Successful

To be responsive is

the action of reacting

now, not later, not

tomorrow but now.

This act plays a

Every salesperson is challenged with growing sales, adding more customers and increasing revenue. Let's face it: that is why you are in business and that is why you've chosen sales as your profession. Unfortunately, too many salespeople do not stop and ask themselves the question "why am I not growing according to plan or goal? Where

are my weaknesses and how do I identify and strengthen them?"

Professional salespeople are the possessors of many strengths and weaknesses and in this article I am going to discuss the weakness that seems to get too little attention. That is the act of "responsiveness." In the many workshops I've conducted and the individuals I have

tutored and mentored, the act of being responsive seems to take on a variety of interpretations, all of which miss the critical definition, meaning and value of being responsive. To be responsive is the action of reacting now, not later, not tomorrow but now. This act plays a critical role in many of the steps of the sales process, and we'll take a look at one of those steps in this article and the critical value of being responsive. The content of what I will describe and discuss comes directly from discussions in my workshops and individual classes.

Leads are the lifeline for sales success. Unless you have a plan and a marketing program for creating leads, your chances of success are significantly minimized.

Leads must be recognized with a mentality that says someone has made a decision to buy from me and my challenge now is to prove to them they made the right decision. The weakness exhibited too

often is the lapse of time that expires between receiving a lead and responding. As time moves on, the quality of the lead diminishes.

You want to grow your company. You want to increase sales. However, all too often, leads are being neglected or ignored because you fail to implement a plan to respond promptly to those leads and you become "too busy to get to the lead." Now, what happens to those leads that you neglected? That's right - they go right to your competitor. Based on the assumption that sales teams receive leads daily, salespeople should have a consistent plan to follow up these leads. Leads are costly to cultivate and too important to address randomly.

To be sure that every lead is addressed responsively, that is now not later, your plan should be based on the average volume of

leads you receive daily. Yes, daily, not weekly. Recognizing that the critical action for following up a lead is to get the appointment, each response should not require more than just a few minutes. Using this as a barometer multiply the number of leads you receive daily by, let's use three minutes, to determine how much time you must set aside each morning to respond to leads. So, for ten leads per day you need a dedicated thirty minutes of response time each day. Since leads do come in during the day, you should also allow for some time at the end of the day for this response to leads. If you believe you cannot set aside this valuable time, then it is time to rethink

your entire sales program.

With a solid plan you can not only preserve the integrity of the lead but also set your appointments so that you avoid conflicts. Your plan should include a very brief response with benefits and value confirming to the prospect that they made the right choice to contact you. You are not selling your product or service at this time but you are creating that very important first impression. You should also respond to all leads rather than cherry picking and making assumptions as to qualifications. It only takes a couple of minutes to respond and identify the value of the lead. Remember, leads are the lifeline of a successful business. Responsiveness is the critical action for success.

# Honeywell Provides Aid to Sandy First Responders


Honeywell announced it is donating more than \$600,000 in first responder products to aid in relief and recovery efforts in areas devastated by Hurricane Sandy. Honeywell will donate more than 19,000 personal protective products including protective footwear, gloves, hoods and helmets, designed to weather the most arduous conditions first responders face every day. The protective gear will be distributed via the Nassau County Office of Emergency Management in Long Island, New York, to first responder teams in affected areas in New York and New Jersey.

"As the world's leading provider of personal protective equipment, we are deeply committed to worker safety and to helping those on the front lines of rescue and recovery efforts remain safe," said Honeywell Chairman and Chief Executive Officer Dave Cote. Beginning May 1, 2013, the state Board of Technical Registration will issue certificates (licenses) to alarm businesses and agents who satisfactorily pass a criminal background check. As of October 1, 2013, a person shall not operate an alarm business unless they receive a certificate from the Board. Cities will no longer be able to require city licensure of companies and agents. 

# CSLB Enforces Zero Tolerance

The Contractors State License Board (CSLB) established a zero-tolerance enforcement policy and now issues legal action against any C-10 Electrical contractor who willfully employs an uncertified electrician to perform work as an electrician. CSLB is legally required to open an investigation and initiate disciplinary action against the contractor (which may include license suspension or revocation) within 60 days of receipt of a referral or complaint from the Department of Industrial Relations' Division of Apprenticeship

Standards (DAS). Labor Code Section 3099.2 stipulates that anyone who performs work as an electrician for C-10 Electrical contractors shall hold an electrical certification card issued by DAS; DAS is required by Labor Code Section 3099.2 to report violations to CSLB. 
