### LEGISLATIVE WATCH

California State Legislative Report July 16, 2013 – August 12,2013

#### **Current Status of Watched Bills**

AB 56 - Bill would require the installation of CO alarms or detectors within educational occupancies under certain restrictions. Since the last report the bill has had a further revision. No committee action has been taken and the bill still is holding on action by the Senate Committee on Appropriations.

AB 462 -Bill as introduced would require that an automatic fire sprinkler system be installed in Residential Care Facilities. Since the last report there has been no action.

AB 972 - The Bill as amended prior to the last report would require that certified payroll records on projects that require a certified electrician to provide the electrician's state certification number below the individual's name. Since the last report there has be no action.

AB 1076 – Bill as amended would authorize panic buttons to be installed in educational occupancies. Since the last report there has been no action.

AB 1140 – Bill would make changes to the Prevailing Wage Law. Since the last report there has been no action.

AB 1236 - Bill would amend the requirements for licensed contractors organized as a limited liability company (LLC). Since the last report this Bill has passed the full Senate 29 to 0. There was a number of abstentions. The Bill has now been enrolled and awaits the Governor to either sign into law or veto. There is no organizations in opposition to this Bill.

AB 1333 - This bill would require that any contract between a public entity and a private entity that has a value of \$250,000 (USD) or greater that has an evergreen clause be reviewed by the public entity and be rescinded if it is found that the private entity is not paying the prevailing wage for the work being performed. Since the last report there has been not action.

AB 1336 - This bill would extend the statute of limitation for civil action for failure to pay prevailing wages brought by specified joint labor-management committees from 180 days to 24 months after the wages were due. Since the last report there has been no action.

SB 556 - This bill provides that a public agency that contracts for labor or services with a contractor is jointly and severally liable for any damages caused during or in connection with the performance of work performed under the contract if certain circumstances exist that cause a member of the public to believe that the contractor or his employee was an agent for the public agency. Since the last report there has been no action.

#### When Business Gets Slow!

Staying busy month after month is clearly a challenge for most businesses. However, using your time wisely during those periods when you are experiencing a slowdown in business is critical to the future growth of your business. Simply stated, the best way to strengthen your business next month is to grow your opportunities this month. Waiting till next month is too late. You need to jumpstart tomorrow

today. Here are a few ways to address these challenges.


Stay in touch with your existing customers. All too often salespeople forget a cliché which is so important to business growth. That cliché is "your best opportunity for new business is your existing customer." I am so disheartened to learn how many salespeople do not have a plan to stay close to those who have done business with them in the past. These are new business opportunities where you are already known. You have already been through and passed their decision-making process. They are not only your opportunity for new business but also your source for quality referrals. Develop your plan to contact these customers on a regular basis. Depending on your business, it might be once a month, once a quarter or once every six months. Develop the plan that will work best in your business. Create the plan and work it. Pick up the phone and call them to reestablish and strengthen your relationship. Yes, pick up the phone and call. E-mails and other electronic communications are not personal enough. Depending on how many existing customers you have you may want to set aside a few hours each week to get to all of them. You only need a few minutes to thank them for their business, introduce something new and ask for referrals. During a slow period make more calls.

Accelerate your networking opportunities. There are many networking groups where you can talk to other business people and

create new opportunities for yourself. There are local business networks, professional networks, industry related associations and networks and a myriad more I am sure you can locate in your region of business opportunities. These groups are specifically created for business people to meet business people and generate leads for new business opportunities. Join these groups, attend their events and be prepared with your sixty second "elevator pitch" to immediately grab the attention of the other person. Since you want to speak to as many other business people as possible at each of these events, you want the other person to instantly identify with the benefits and value of the product or service you represent. Once they can identify where your business can be helpful to them, the process of exchanging business references begins. Even if that person is not a qualified prospect they may know someone who is and will pass your contact information on to them. Networking should not be viewed as a one-time exercise employed only when you are experiencing a slow business period. For networking to be effective you should be seen as often as possible at these events. Add networking into your complete marketing program.

In the first paragraph I talked about staying in touch and following up with your existing customers. Now let's take a look at following up leads. Here is another cliché to remember. "Leads are the lifeline for a successful business." Yes, without leads there are no opportunities for appointments and ultimately sales. What salespeople should remember about leads is "if someone has contacted you they have already made the decision they want to buy from you. It is your challenge to prove to them they made the right decision." So, why do so many salespeople never make that second call to follow up on a lead? It's perplexing but it is a reality. Some statistics have it as high as 80% of the leads never get a second call. Well, now you are experiencing a slow period, so why not dig out all those leads that were never effectively addressed



#### **United States Congress:**

No changes on the Bills reported at the last meeting. The Congress is in summer recess.

Safe Building Code Incentive Act (SBCIA) — Would provide financial incentives for states to adopt and enforce building codes. This Bill would provide qualifying states with an additional four (4) percent of Stafford Act grant funding available for post-disaster assistance if builders and contractors use nationally recognized model building codes. Specifically, states would need to adopt and enforce the International Residential Code (IRC) from the two most recent editions. This Bill is supported by the International Association of Fire Chiefs (IAFC) and the California State Fire Marshal has brought it to the attention of the Northern and Southern California Fire Prevention Officers Associations.

Electronic Life Safety and Security Systems Federal Background Check Act of 2013 – No change in the status of this bill since my last report. This is the Bill that the ESA is the principal sponsor of.

Online Communication and Geolocation Protection Act (H.R. 983) – This Bill has been authored by Rep. Zoe Lofgren (CA-19). This legislation would prohibit the interception, disclosure and use

of geolocation information by the government except under specified exceptions. This Bill would also prohibit the disclosure of geolocation information to the government by an entity providing services unless one of these exceptions apply. The exceptions include conducting foreign intelligence surveillance, consent has been obtained from the individual, the information is already in the public domain, emergency assistance or a warrant has been obtained. Since various alarm companies provide asset tracking services and PERS that may involve location information, and this location may be disclosed to public safety (governmental) entities, this Bill may require watching.

Fire Sprinkler Incentive Act of 2013 (FSIA) – This Bill would encourage commercial building owners to invest in life saving fire safety upgrades. Would provide tax incentives for building owners to install fire sprinkler retrofits. A version of this Bill has been in the Congress since 2003. The Bill however has no provisions for the installation of an automatic fire alarm system. The Bill is being supported by the National Fire Sprinkler Association (NFSA), American Fire Sprinkler Association (AFSA), National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and the Congressional Fire Services Institute (CFSI). The alarm industry needs to push for a balance approach to fire protection, detection and suppression.

#### **CSLB Enforces Zero Tolerance**

The Contractors State License Board (CSLB) established a zero-tolerance enforcement policy and now issues legal action against any C-10 Electrical contractor who willfully employs an uncertified electrician to perform work as an electrician. CSLB is legally required to open an investigation and initiate disciplinary action against the contractor (which may include license suspension or revocation) within 60 days of receipt of a referral or complaint from the Department of Industrial Relations' Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS). Labor Code Section 3099.2 stipulates that anyone who performs work as an electrician for C-10 Electrical contractors shall hold an electrical certification card issued by DAS; DAS is required by Labor Code Section 3099.2 to report violations to CSLB. 
