What Do Prospects Care About?

For those of you who have heard me speak, you know I have used the acronym WIIFM

more than once. Simply stated, this translates to "What's In It for Me" and that is what is on the mind of prospects today. Prospects care about themselves and the challenges they face to grow their business and support and protect their families.

All too often salespeople will find it difficult to understand why they are not connecting with the prospect. Why isn't the prospect as excited as you are about what you are telling them? It's probably because you are talking about you, your company and your products or service. This is your favorite subject. And, well, you should be talking about how well you service your customers, the strength and reputation of your company and the quality and reliability of your products. However, you must never forget that the sales call is not about you, and although prospects may be interested in you, those are not the first comments the prospect is anxiously waiting to hear. Prospects have challenges, possibly problems, and they want to hear how the benefits and solutions of your products or service directly address those challenges and problems. When this resonates with them they will want to hear more. So back off, for a while, about talking about yourself and focus on discussing what matters to them.

To begin with you must learn from the prospect what their challenges and problems are. There are two very effective ways to get this information. First, you can ask. This is simple and right to the point. What are your challenges and problems? The prospect may or may not tell you all you need to know depending on how much they want to say at the time. I prefer the second method which is to



Now it is your turn to listen. It is important to remember that when the prospect believes that you truly understand a situation such as theirs they will tell all. So, before zeroing in on any specific solutions for the prospect, listen very carefully to what they are telling you. Listening to the prospect and giving them all the time they need to finish what they are saying is the first critical step in learning the details of the prospects challenges and problems. Listening carefully and asking questions directly related to the challenges and problems that the prospect has divulged places you in a much better position to recommend the correct solution to their needs. Once the prospect recognizes and identifies with your solution, that addresses their challenges and problems, you are ready to close.

A critical step to your success is to remember WIIFM. The sales call is about the prospect and their challenges.

CSLB Enforces Zero Tolerance

The Contractors State License Board (CSLB) issues legal action against any C-10 Electrical contractor who willfully employs an uncertified electrician to perform work as an electrician. CSLB is legally required to open an investigation and initiate disciplinary action against the contractor (which may include license suspension or revocation) within 60 days of receipt of a referral or complaint from the Department of Industrial Relations' Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS). Labor Code Section 3099.2 stipulates that anyone who performs work as an electrician for C-10 Electrical contractors shall hold an electrical certification card issued by DAS; DAS is required by Labor Code Section 3099.2 to report violations to CSLB. 


