

#### **Successful Sales Management**

The success or failure of a company is often directly related to sales management. Even though there are many factors such as marketing, design, production, quality control, competition and the economy that have a direct effect on success or failure, it all begins and ends with the sales manager. Unquestionably, the sales manager cannot control the volatility of any of these factors. However, the sales manager can and must be the source that strengthens the effectiveness of their sales team regardless of how any of these factors will affect overall sales. The sales manager must provide the wisdom, expertise and support to their sales team

so that they identify their selling skills and apply the resources to effectively strengthen and employ them. This must be part of a plan that is implemented 365 days a year, not only when a negative occurrence in the business environment presents itself.

This brings us to the necessity of creating that effective sales plan. The creation of an effective sales plan will allow the sales manager to adjust to the current environment of their business and be decisive in their leadership role. There are many critical criteria to an effective sales plan and here we will look at some of them.

Interestingly, the plan must begin with the recruitment of the sales team. Sales managers do not have crystal balls and cannot predict the success or failure of a salesperson they are interviewing. However, they should have a set of criteria that will lead them to their choice for the position. All sales managers will not use the same criteria so here are some ideas. Pick the ones that will work for you. First and foremost is answering the question, "where are you looking for candidates"? The answer to that question should be "everywhere". Some examples of "everywhere" are: within your own organization; from vendors; recommendations; your customers' social media; and of course agencies. Your interview with the candidate must begin with that all important first impression. Following this you want to carefully evaluate responses to your comments and questions. Try to identify the candidates' understanding of

relationships, their achievement motivation, ambition to meet goals and challenges, and self-confidence. Finally, you might choose the one who has sold you.

The role of successful leadership will depend on the strength and success of the team. As a manager you must identify with the kind of relationship you want to enjoy with your team. Your plan must allow you to be their friend, coach, trainer and mentor. Your plan must enable you to develop employee loyalty, and that is accomplished when you lead by opportunity, not intimidation. Included in your plan must be the opportunity to praise accomplishments while at the same time analyzing failures. Accomplishments should be recognized both privately and publicly, while failures should be viewed as part of the learning program you have for your team.

A critical component of your plan must include supporting and motivating your team. This begins with two simple questions. How often do you visit with your salespeople in their territory? How often do you review their territory plans, objectives and results? Don't be an absentee manager. Visit with every member of your team as often as possible. Depending on the size of your team and the market into which they sell, this could be once a month, once every three months, etc. Allot enough time during these visits to analyze their activities and provide the advice and support to guide them moving forward. At the same time, you can answer question number two. That is to review their territory management, their objectives for the territory and some of their recent results. Spending this time with the salesperson will strengthen your relationship with them and they will truly view you as their friend, coach, trainer and mentor.

Every member of the sales team will recognize and react positively to a well-organized sales plan. Quickly distinguished

will be an escalation of confidence and stability within the team The sales manager, who carries the burden of sales success for the company, will strengthen their relationship with the sales team while motivating them and gaining their support to go that extra mile for the company. What is required to be a successful sales manager is a logical workable sales plan.

## A Dealer's Perspective — #12

Are you thinking about adding or expanding the use of Smart Devices to your residential security package? The Smart Home, by almost any measurement, is predicted to be in over 50% of homes within the next 20 years. The Internet of Things (IoT) is a plethora of devices, from a Smart Camera for a security system to a tricked-out elevator in someone's home. Each of these IoT devices will likely be controlled by a Smart Control Panel, with ultimate control residing in the customer and a phone app. One of the major problems as communication networks move toward adoption of 5G technology is protection of the data passing through the system and shielding the system from external activity like hacking. The

Jan. 29, 2015, issue of Forbes magazine clearly illustrates how two different companies, Simply Safe and LaserShield, could be easily penetrated and manipulated with a minimal investment in off-the-shelf equipment. Additional problems like the no-notice dropping of 3G transmissions or unprotected internet access (Wi Fi) complicate the equation.

While adoption of IoT, in all its many forms, is well underway, the numbers are still relatively small. Current estimates peg security penetration at about 25%, and DIY will, perhaps, add a few points to that. Often forgotten in the hoopla over IoT is that most of these devices will generate little or no RMR for the residential dealer. Maintenance contracts and good margins from installations don't look like monitoring revenue. The secret to creating a better growth path will be to protect the network and their devices from hacking, and the manipulation of your customers data. The first step is to segregate the physical doorway to a customer's home from his "Digital Doorway" and deliver solutions that offer protection to each of these two key areas. We, as an industry, have created some spectacularly successful devices for installation in the residential space. Video has developed a huge market because of wireless 1080p, and color cameras with Artificial Intelligence. We are, however, still trying to find a way to put a device on your toaster that will keep it from burning your bage!!

Most panel manufacturers utilize open architecture in the design of their panels focusing on Linux or Android because there are many developers who build apps in those languages. There are, however, always a few who will develop malware that will penetrate a typical panel. Closed architecture that keeps out these bad actors is the proper technology to use. It restricts manufacturers to development of their own firmware applications, which is more expensive and not as efficient. The dealer should then have the confidence that no one can access the panel without his permission. In addition to closed architecture, curtailing access by encryption and the use of Spread Spectrum will place total control with the dealer and defeat takeovers as well as hacking.

There are currently four manufacturers that I am aware of, that provide a level of encryption and spread spectrum in their equipment configurations. Alula (formerly Resolution Products) is one of them. They are focused on protecting their dealers and giving them piece of mind with their Connect+ panel. DMP has been using Spread Spectrum since 2002 and their encrypted wireless Fire Systems have been approved by UL. Honeywell is equally focused on encryption for their current and future panels and devices. Reportedly, Honeywell's acquisition of Videofied and its "Motion Viewer" technology was intended to jump start their adoption of encryption to their extensive line of panels and devices. Cinch Systems, in Minnesota, is known for providing the State Department with the encrypted security panels and devices they use in our embassies abroad. Their MaxOut Technologies division is making encrypted panels and devices for Intelogix (UTC), Qolsys, and Elk. The manufacturing sector has recognized the importance of encryption, and it is time that dealers join the party even if it does increase our cost slightly.

The next step after installing encrypted panels and devices is to provide the alarm customer with software and insurance to protect his network and system from a breach. There are some software packages (without insurance) on the market, but care should be taken to ensure they do not originate in a nation-state that is at odds with the U.S. Hopefully, Congress will insist that Huawei (a Chinese company) cannot sell equipment in the country, especially 5G components. There are reports surfacing that a new company is forming to provide protective software and some level of insurance specifically for residential and small commercial alarm clients. They will market this coverage as SaaS (Software as a Service), which will create additional RMR for the dealer. More on this possible new revenue opportunity next month.

#### **Monitoring Associations Dispute Google's Statement**

Recent reporting by Business Insider, CNN Business and many other publications have highlighted the undisclosed, on-board microphone discovered in Google's Nest Guard Security Device—raising serious privacy concerns among consumers. The Monitoring Association (TMA) and the Electronic Security Association (ESA), trade associations representing professionals who install and monitor security and life safety technologies in homes and businesses, call into question the validity of Google's published statements concerning the use of microphones in security devices. According to TMA and ESA, statements such as, "security systems often include microphones to provide features that rely on sound sensing," misrepresent the vast majority of today's residential security systems installed throughout the country.

Since audio recording includes privacy and legal complexities, it's not extremely common in residential installations. Security professionals and integrators consult with customers and ensure all federal and state laws are abided by.

"Adding audio surveillance can certainly make for a more robust system," says ESA President, Chris Mosley. "We're seeing exciting advancements in the audio surveillance category, such as acoustic sensors and microphones that can help us detect gunfire or when voices become elevated that could indicate potential violence. 

#### **CSLB Enforces Zero Tolerance**

The Contractors State License Board (CSLB) is legally required to open an investigation and initiate disciplinary action against the contractor (which may include license suspension or revocation) within 60 days of receipt of a referral or complaint from the Department of Industrial Relations' Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS). Labor Code Section 3099.2 stipulates that anyone who performs work as an electrician for C-10 Electrical contractors shall hold an electrical certification card issued by DAS; DAS is required by Labor Code Section 3099.2 to report violations to CSLB.
