



It was during this time of his life that he decided to put pen to paper and make his experience available to anyone who needed it. In the next decade he penned 3 books on successful sales and management techniques. But Harvey was so much more than a consummate salesperson: his

greatest job was that of a Son, Brother, Husband, Father, Grandfather and finally Great Grandfather. The last 2 positions brought him the greatest joy of his life.

He would often be heard saying "had I known Grandchildren would be this much fun I would have had them first." Harvey was a family man, first and foremost. Nothing came

before family to Harvey. He was a devoted son to his parents and was a cherished brother to Myrna. He was a kind and loving husband to Judy. He was an amazing father to Paul, Steven and Jay. He was a huge figure in his grandchildren's lives, always there and invested in Christopher, Madison and Sasha. And finally he was delighted by the arrival of his great grandchild and namesake Harvey. Harvey was preceded in death by his parents Herman and Etta, and his wife Judy. Harvey is survived by his sister and her family, 3 sons, 3 daughters in law, 3 grandchildren and their families, and his



great grandchild. And Grand Dad to doggies Emmy, Teno and Benji (the cat) The impact on all of our lives will be felt for the rest of our lives. The effect that he has had on so many lives is immeasurable. And he joins his love of his life Judy. He will be remembered as a great father, grandfather, mentor, salesman and man."

Deputy Chief of Police for Oakland, Drennon Lindsey, joined our March virtual meeting of Bay Area CAA chapters. Members from EBAA, GGAA, SVAA, and RAA attended by Zoom. As the leader of Oakland's Bureau of Investigations, Deputy Chief Lindsey described what was once a "police operations center" and is now becoming more like a "central intelligence information center" that can identify and apprehend criminal suspects more rapidly. Oakland has an intel unit and crime analyst unit that wants to use video security and audio data provided by victims to allow investigations and police operations to move faster. Lyndsey described the technical struggles they encounter, though, getting video from a victim's recorder into the info center. The group discussed technology that can allow victims to transmit permission-based video data over the cloud. Mike Salk, President of CAA, brainstormed ways a victim could upload video to a police report portal, and made a case for why video transported on a USB is not ideal. Salk also provided a history of how Oakland's alarm ordinance evolved and became a model ordinance for cities across the country. Lindsey echoed the need to focus on reducing false alarms, based on her experience as a patrol officer who knows what it is like to get called to the same address again and again. Police response is spread thin, she said, and property crime reports are a lower priority than the felony crimes they are fighting. Her 24 years of law enforcement experience, achievements, and advanced education were very impressive.





CSLB Enforces Zero Tolerance

The Contractors State License Board (CSLB) is legally required to open an investigation and initiate disciplinary action against the contractor (which may include license suspension or revocation) within 60 days of receipt of a referral or complaint from the Department of Industrial Relations' Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS). Labor Code Section 3099.2 stipulates that anyone who performs work as an electrician for C-10 Electrical contractors shall hold an electrical certification card issued by DAS; DAS is required by Labor Code Section 3099.2 to report violations to CSLB. Disciplinary Review Committees (DRCs) are comprised of five members, appointed by the governor, with three members actively engaged in business as licensees and two members from the general public who are interested in public safety. DRCs are established to consider appeals regarding the Bureau's denials, suspensions, and revocations of licenses under its purview, as well as the assessment of administrative fines.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Applicants must be interested in public safety, be able to utilize objective critical thinking skills, and attend meetings consistently and punctually. Californians from all backgrounds are encouraged to apply!

WHY SHOULD I SERVE?

Serving in a DRC gives licensees a chance to lead, influence, and enforce their industry standards. For members of the public, getting involved in a DRC is a great way to learn more about consumer protections, serve your community and your state, and build your resume!

WHAT'S THE COMMITMENT?

Members serve a two-year term at the pleasure of the governor. Depending on the needs of the specific committee, meetings are held 2–12 times per year. Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 103, appointed members shall be paid a per diem of \$100 and shall be reimbursed for travel expenses.
