## Big Changes Underway — Are You Aware and Ready for Them?

Yes, change seems to be the natural order of things, but as 2019 came to a close, our industry was besieged by cyber security concerns, the mystery of artificial intelligence, the entrance of Amazon and Google into the industry, and the disintegration of the State/National Chapter relationship.

I am going to focus this article on the latter development and the concerns and opportunities it presents to each of us. As a past President (2000) and current member of the Communications Committee for the California Alarm Association, I have an interesting perch from which to view our new position.

#### **Chapter Participation**

We have 11 chapters within the CAA and the WBFAA to anchor our personal participation. We, as members, are fortunate to have strong leadership with the CAA Executive Committee and Board of Directors, but they can only do so much. Each state chapter is the alarm association for their area. This is the backbone of the

CAA. Without strong chapters, the CAA cannot continue to be the formidable industry presence that it is now. Paying your state and local dues is important, but that is not participation. Each Chapter has an obligation to provide networking and training to its members. They are required to maintain the appropriate books and records for tax and legal purposes, but, most importantly, they are obligated to seek and enroll new members for the Chapter and State. The CAA has a Membership Committee, and it is laser focused on bringing in new members, but the Committee needs local participation to be successful. The smaller the local association, the more difficult it is to provide a quality networking experience and participate in training opportunities.

#### First Responder And Political Participation

There is synergism in action when you combine new member solicitation with first responder and political outreach. Nothing works better to convince a fellow alarm dealer to become a member than inviting them along when you visit a local police chief or have a state representative in for a lunch meeting. Our Legislative Advocate is the best, but their job is much easier if our state senators and assemblymen already appreciate the importance of our industry to their constituents. You can be assured that developing these relationships will be very good for your business.

## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


Dear CAA Member,





## **Make Sales Training Sessions Effective**

A question that many corporate executives fail to ask is why their sales training sessions are not as successful as they had planned. Well, the key word here is "planned" wherein many sales training programs are not effectively planned for the desired outcome. All too often corporations conduct sales training sessions without the aforethought of a strategic plan focused on specific business growth results. They tend to concentrate a formidable amount of training time to technology and product knowledge with an insufficient amount of training time focused on the sales processes that will move the prospect

over to the salesperson's side. It is unquestionably critical that salespeople be familiar with and knowledgeable about the technology of their product or service. However, it is equally important that the prospect recognizes

that the salesperson truly understands their concerns and is engaged in providing solutions focused specifically on their need. That is what closes sales successfully.

Due to the lack of a strategic sales training plan, most programs fall short of this objective. They fall short when it comes to instructing the attendees on identifying and employing the assets they possess, that will move the prospect over to their side resulting in sales success. Owing to this, the long-term business growth objectives are too often not realized. So, what are the assets that every salesperson possesses? Simply stated they are their personal selling skills within the control of the salesperson.

Corporations must pay more attention in the planning process of their sales training programs to strategically focus on the objectives of the program, and how the salesperson will employ their personal selling skills to achieve those objectives. To reach the business growth objectives set forth in the plan, an effective sales training program must begin with the identification and acknowledgement of the goals of the program. This must be followed with the identification and recognition of the salesperson's personal selling skills, wherein the training session must deliver the tools and knowledge that will be required to effectively and successfully strengthen and employ those skills. The personal selling skills already possessed by most salespeople fall into the following categories: mentality, relationships, understanding, presentation, engagement, empowerment and follow up. Within each of these categories there are key techniques and exercises that will guide the salesperson to differentiating themselves from their competition, from their opening comments to delivery of the solution, while strengthening their relationship with the prospect. This competitive differentiation lies within the personal selling skills of the salesperson and their capability to strengthen and successfully employ them. Every sales training program must embrace the tools and knowledge that will focus on these skills and effectively lead to sales success.

All of the above must be part of the sales training plan to achieve the objectives and/or goals set forth in the business growth plan. Sales training must be considered an ongoing program and not a onetime activity. The salesperson's improvement as a result of an effective training session will require practice by the salesperson, feedback to management and support by management. It is necessary for a sales training program to be successful that it be aligned with management's objectives and/or goals while strengthening the personal selling skills of the salespeople and their effective employment of these skills. To ensure that your corporate training program is a success, you must take a meaningful look at these essentials of training while never forgetting that management follow up with the salespeople, continuous training sessions and the salesperson's practice ethics are critical to achieving successful results. The lack of any of these activities has been the foundation for the failure of many training programs.

#### **Communication And Training**

The above participation and activities would be very difficult without the CAA portion of the equation. The role of the CAA and its management is to provide the tools you need to fully participate in your local and state associations. The Communication and Membership Committees will provide you with the web site interface to communicate with your dealer members, non-members and the public. It will be managed by the CAA office which will work directly with your chapters to keep it updated. The CAA will continue to produce two trade shows (conventions) per year to provide on-site education to members. The CAA plans to launch a series of webinars and YouTube presentations that will build on the existing training and roll it out to the membership. The goal is to use vendor fees for this additional service to help keep member dues to a minimum. Perhaps the
