The California wildfires have been particularly brutal this year. Some of our clients have lost customers due to their homes and businesses being destroyed, and the economic effects will continue for years. The IRS is providing some relief to taxpayers in Shasta County and I expect that similar relief will be provided in other By Mitch Reitman areas of the State. Following the

recent disaster declaration for individual assistance issued by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, the IRS said affected taxpayers who reside or have a business in Shasta County may qualify for tax relief.

The declaration permits the IRS to postpone certain deadlines for taxpavers who reside or have a business in the disaster area. For instance, certain deadlines falling on or after July 23 and before November 30 are granted additional time to file through November 30. This includes taxpayers who had a valid extension to file their 2017 return due to run out on October 15.

It also includes the quarterly estimated income tax payments due on September 17 and the quarterly payroll and excise tax returns normally due on July 31 and October 31. It also includes tax-exempt organizations that operate on a calendar-year basis and had an automatic extension due to run out on November 15.

If an affected taxpayer receives a late filing or late payment penalty notice from the IRS that has an original or extended filing, payment or deposit due date that falls within the postponement period, the taxpayer should call the telephone number on the notice to have the IRS abate the penalty.

The IRS automatically identifies taxpayers in the covered disaster area and applies automatic filing and payment relief. Affected taxpayers who reside or have a business outside the covered disaster area must call the IRS disaster hotline at 866-562-5227 to request this relief.

Your Presentation Opens the Door to Success

Successful sales professionals will be the first to reflect that their success is a direct result of the preparation and practice of their presentations to effect maximum impact. They recognize and understand that their presentation must be compelling to persuade and convince the prospect without any possibility of misinterpretation. In addition to being effective in closing the sale, the presentation must leave the door open for future business and quality referrals. Effective presentations are the backbone of the salespersons success. Before a salesperson can become a

successful closer they must first be a persuasive presenter. Once they have conquered this challenge they have stepped into the path to reach the pin-

nacle of selling. The presentation must be recognized as the foundation of the entire sales process. Effective presentations are ones that lead with logic and assurance from the opening to the close. The presentation is where the salesperson develops and strengthens a partnership with the prospect. Understanding the basic requirements and effective planning of your presentation is the cornerstone for opening the door to success.

The first few seconds with a prospect are decisively important. Do not underestimate the fact that you are immediately facing the competition of what is in the prospects mind and what they are identifying is important to them. You must seize their instant and undivided attention by focusing your opening comments on what you know is important to them. Remember, the one thought in their mind that you can always rely on is What's in it for me? This is a question that must be immediately answered and critically important is the fact that you must keep on addressing and answering this

> question throughout your presentation. To keep the prospect's attention and begin the process of moving them over to your side, you must focus your talking points on that which relates their need to your product or service.

It is very important to remember that to get the prospect to pay attention to your second comment they must resonate positively with your first comment. So, arousing their interest and seizing their attention in those first few seconds is critical. Once you have their attention and remembering that prospects are only concerned with how their needs will be served, you must convert that attention into what they perceive as a benefit to them. To arouse their attention you must immediately deliver some of those benefits that the prospect will recognize they will gain from your product or service. Notice the key word is benefits not features. Benefits provide tangible results while features represent the mechanics of how these results are obtained. Although features are an important component of your presentation it is the benefits that will motivate the prospect to an informative open discussion providing a wealth of critical information for your sales call. Features will be brought in later in the presentation to support the benefits. As the professional salesperson you understand your prospects business and the benefits of your product or service that will appeal most to them. Communicate that appeal.

Think of the presentation as the heart and soul of the sales process. Currently, you are past all the preliminaries and face to face with the prospect experiencing your opportunity to make the sale or lose it. The prospect has given you the time for your presentation, but the question now is, are they going to listen to what you are presenting? You must capture their attention and hold onto it while your presentation stimulates the prospects desire for your product or service and energizes their motivation to buy. If you have aroused their interest and stimulated their desire for your product or service during your presentation they will listen. 





Labor Code Section 3099.2 stipulates that anyone


