The George A. Weinstock Award was established by the CAA in 1999 as our highest honor. Since 2000, the award has been presented annually to a member of the alarm industry, recognizing their lifetime achievements and contributions to the field.

I would like to sincerely congratulate Dave Michel on being honored with the George A. Weinstock Award for Lifetime Achievement. This prestigious award is a testament to your exceptional dedication and contributions to the security and life safety industry. Your innovative work, leadership, and commitment to advancing our field have not only set high standards but also inspired many within our community.

CAA President Tony Smith presented George Weinstock with a Lifetime Achievement Award at the CAA Winter Convention in 1999 and announced the establishment of the George A. Weinstock Award.

GEORGE A. WEINSTOCK AWARD

George Weinstock entered the security industry in 1955 when he joined the family's Morse Signal Devices of California, where he served as President from 1970 to 1981. He was concurrently President of Morse Signal Devices of Cleveland and partner and director of Ans-R-Tel Answering Service / Broadway Le Mesa Answering Services of San Diego. He sold that business to partner Robert Berlin in 1983 and established American Home Security. He was President, Director and CEO of American Home Security from 1984 until 1993 when he sold the company to Protection One where he served as Executive Vice President.

George participated in our organizations from the moment he entered the industry. His role model was his father Morris, who the industry has honored with the presentation by the ESA of the Morris F. Weinstock Award since 1970 to honor the Person of the Year.

George chaired his first NBFAA committee in 1969, and was elected President of the national organization in 1973.

In 1976, he was elected President of the Western Burglar & Fire Alarm Association, the organization that preceded the CAA. Over the years, he has served as Director, Chair or other leadership position in an array of organizations that serve the industry.

George served on the California Alarm Association Board of Directors as Large Company Representative, and was the founding Chair of the CAA Newsletter Committee that produces THE MIRROR.

The California Alarm Association presented him with a Lifetime Achievement Award at the 1999 CAA Winter Convention and announced the establishment of the George A. Weinstock Award as the highest honor to be bestowed by the Association.

Dave Michel: 2023 CAA George A. Weinstock Award

David Michel started his career in the electronic security industry at Valley Alarm in 1995. At that time, Valley Alarm was an established, but small, local alarm company with approximately 1,000 accounts and \$35,000 of recurring monthly revenue. Dave began in the Administrative Department answering phones and performing clerical duties.

After just three months at Valley Alarm, his responsibilities increased dramatically when Valley Alarm's President, Bob Michel, took a six-month assignment in Chicago as a Director at SecurityLink.

Dave quickly progressed to Controller and took over Operations in 1999 and then

Vice President of Valley Alarm in 2000. He became President of Valley Alarm in 2005 and he and Edward Michel became Co-Presidents in 2015.

From 1997 to 2001, Dave managed Valley Alarm's subcontracting work for Edison Security. This involved the direct oversight of installation, inventory and billing for 300 small systems per month. These installations were in addition to Valley Alarm's in-house sales and installations.

In 2001, Dave managed the successful conversion of Valley Alarm's financial software from an obsolete DOS program to a brand-new Windows based product called Sedona Office. Valley Alarm was the first user to actually implement this product, which is now used by hundreds of larger alarm companies nationwide. Dave is largely self-taught in bookkeeping and accounting and he developed financial processes, reports and financial statements to meet the requirements of Valley Alarm's new lender, SLP Capital. These processes and reporting capabilities eventually facilitated Valley Alarm's ability to transition from high interest alarm industry financing to traditional business bank financing.

In 2002, Dave managed the successful transfer of Valley Alarm's central station monitoring from NACC to NMC.

In 2004, Valley Alarm more than doubled its RMR when it acquired Millennium Security. Millennium Security had about 3,300 accounts and almost

\$100,000 of RMR. Dave oversaw the financial analysis, due diligence, central station transfer and assimilation of Millennium's accounts. This process was accomplished economically and on schedule and he also oversaw over 30 acquisitions ranging in size from 50 to 1,500 accounts.

In early 2006, Dave was instrumental in the development of a new Valley Alarm program to create a company culture of excellence and customer perceived value.

Dave was instrumental in the growth of Valley Alarm to its current size of over 10,000 customers and \$450,000 RMR and they have been an SDM Top 100 company since 2007.

Dave majored in engineering at the University of Notre Dame and later advanced his engineering studies at the University of California at Irvine. He continues his business and management education through numerous seminars and avid reading.

Dave is active in alarm trade associations and has been Treasurer of the California Alarm Association (CAA) since 2009. He has served numerous terms as President of the Greater Los Angeles Security Alarm Association (GLASAA). In 2011 he was honored with the Man of the Year award from GLASAA. From 2013-2014, Dave was the California representative to the board of directors of the nationwide Electronic Security Association (ESA).

In 2021, Dave received a commendation from the City of San Fernando for his services to the community. In 2022, Dave received the Chief's Award from the City of San Fernando Police Chief for outstanding support of the San Fernando Police Department.

Dave lives in Long Beach, CA with his wife Karen, who he met while playing intramural softball at the University of California at Irvine. They have two daughters -- Allison, 28 and Lauren, 26. When his daughters were younger, Dave coached and refereed AYSO soccer and was also active in the YMCA Adventure Guides program and worked at their camps.
