ADT Offers \$25,000 Reward to Help Stop Security Sales Scams

Alarmed by an increasing number of consumer complaints about deceptive home security sales tactics, industry leader ADT announced it will award up to \$25,000 for proof of a company training its sales teams to be deceitful. The evidence must result in the successful prosecution of the offending company.

"ADT's trusted brand is being exploited by swindlers and scammers who mislead unsuspecting consumers," said David Bleisch, ADT General Counsel. "Victims end up having their ADT security systems unnecessarily replaced and are duped into signing new contracts with another provider."

The fraud begins at the front door when customers are told false statements ranging from "ADT has gone out of business" to "I am here to upgrade your equipment." Sometimes the scammers claim they are affiliated with alarm panel manufacturers. Before the customer realizes they've been cheated, a new security system has been installed and they've been conned into switching service to the company committing the fraud.

It's usually a crime to use deceptive sales practices, especially when they are targeted toward the elderly. Recently, two sales representatives from a Utah-based security company were arrested in Missouri for misleading an elderly woman into making changes to the ADT system in her home and then charging a higher fee.

To keep from being victimized by security scammers, these tips are recommended:

- · Ask for photo identification and/or a business card of who is at your door
- · Call your current security company to confirm what you're being told
- Don't be pressured into agreeing to new equipment or signing a contract
- Request literature be left behind so you can study it before taking action

ADT already has video evidence from at least one company's training session showing rogue representatives being taught to lie during sales presentations at customer homes. ADT hopes more evidence, obtained through cell phones, will come forward.

Additionally, ADT will continue filing lawsuits against companies and their employees who deceive its customers. Last year, ADT recovered over \$4 million from companies as a result of lawsuits. More information is available at www.adt.com.

ASSOCIATES CORNER The Effective Sales Presentation

An effective sales presentation does not begin with a plethora of features and accolades about your product, your company, your service or pricing. There are many other critical concerns that must be taken into consideration prior to reaching for these important features of your product or service. You must begin by remembering that your competition is ready to tell your prospect the same story that you are ready to deliver.

Regardless of whether or not you believe they can compete with you, they will compete. The difference at this point of time is you and you must first, and foremost, develop and strengthen your relationship with the prospect.

To succeed you must begin by grabbing the attention of the prospect, making them eager to want to hear more of what you have to say. This is accomplished by beginning with a statement or two that immediately resonates with the benefits and/or value of your products or service to them, something they can identify with as being beneficial or useful to a need that they may have. As the sales professional you know the benefits of your product or service and the varying needs and pains they will address. You must deliver these first to secure the interest of the prospect.

Having secured the interest of the prospect, the conversation that follows should provide you with the specific needs of that prospect as defined by them and delivered from their point of view. If your opening statements were presented effectively, you probably will not have to ask any questions to get this information from the prospect. They will recognize your understanding of some or all of their needs and freely tell you all you need to know to move forward.

Armed with this knowledge and the prospect's recognition that you understand their concerns, you now want to focus on the benefits and features of your product or service that relate directly to what the prospect has indicated is their specific need or pain. All of the rest of the features of your product or service are insignificant at this time. In fact they can present a distraction to the prospect from truly recognizing how you can satisfy their specific needs. Stay focused on their concerns and your solutions to those concerns. Once the prospect has accepted and recognizes that you do have the benefits to satisfy their need, or pain, now you can support this solution by presenting the details describing how this will be accomplished with the features of your product or service.

As the experienced sales professional, you also know what some of their objections may be and how you have responded to those objections in the past. Why wait to have to respond to an objection, and be reactive, when you can use that response as a positive comment or benefit before it is raised by the prospect. Being proactive rather than reactive delivers a very decisive message to the prospect that you truly understand the concerns in their thoughts.

And finally, listen very carefully to what the prospect is telling you. Never interrupt them no matter how eagerly you want to respond. Let them finish and then present your response. A very effective way of accomplishing this is to repeat what the prospect has said or asked, and follow that with your response. Repeating the prospect's comment or question prior to your response delivers three significant messages to the prospect. First, you are listening. Second, you do understand what they are saying or asking. And third, clearly it is important to you.

As the motivational speaker Les Brown says "Closing is the logical conclusion to an effective presentation." So, perfect your presentation skills and practice what you have perfected to achieve an effective presentation and begin enjoying the increase in your closing ratio.







CITY OF CHULA VISTA Police Department

The City of Chula Vista announced anew alarm permit program on June 17, 2014 effective July 1, 2014.June 17, 2014 in a letter from Chief of Police David Bejarano. The city has contracted with PMAM Corporation to administer the Security Alarm Program for the Chula Vista Police Department.

The new Security Alarm Ordinance and City Master Fee Schedule call for the following changes:

Fees for security alarm permits have been modified to \$28.75, renewed annually, for both residential and business sites. Two-year alarm permits obtained prior to the new program changes will be honored for the life of the permit.

Fines for false alarm responses by the Police Department will be charged to the permitted site as follows:

a) First violation* \$100

- b) Second violation within one year** \$200
- c) Any additional violations within one year \$500

*Note that the first violation fine may be waived if the alarm permit holder obtains proof of completion of a false alarm awareness course.

**The one year period begins with the first reported false security alarm at the permitted site.

In addition to increased fines for false alarms, any site that has four or more false security alarms within a one year period may be placed on a "verified response" status. When a verified response is required, the Chula Vista Police Department will respond to an alarm only after an actual problem has been verified by a person who is on the premises and reports that a crime may be occurring or has occurred. Verification can also be accomplished by an alarm company monitoring the premises by using remote audio or video indicating that a crime may be occurring or has occurred. Alarm permit holders may be removed from "verified response" by demonstrating compliance with the ordinance and by presenting a plan to eliminate alarms to the City's alarm program administrator.

Security alarm monitoring companies must also practice Enhanced Call Verification under the new ordinance. No alarm system monitoring company shall request a police response to an alarm unless the alarm system monitoring company has already made at least two telephone calls to determine whether the alarm signal is valid. One telephone call shall be made to the premises where the alarm system is located and a second telephone call shall be to an alternate telephone number designated by the alarm user for this purpose. Security alarm monitoring companies are responsible for keeping records verifying that two telephone numbers were called.

Citizens and business owners may obtain permits, update permit information, and pay permit fees and false alarm fines online, by mail or by telephone. The Chula Vista Police Department Security Alarm program can be accessed online at www.cityalarmpermit.com/fams/ citizen/city/chulavista or by telephone at 877-503-6727.







CERTIFICATION – FIRE/LIFE SAFETY TECHNICIAN - RENEWAL

For Fire/Life Safety Technicians with 4,000 hours of work experience, the state law requires them to be certified by passing the state exam. The renewal application is posted at www.dir.ca.gov/ das and the state does not send out reminders. CSLB Enforces Zero Tolerance

The Contractors State License Board (CSLB) issues legal action against any C-10 Electrical contractor who willfully employs an uncertified electrician to perform work as an electrician. CSLB is legally required to open an investigation and initiate disciplinary action against the contractor (which may include license suspension or revocation) within 60 days of receipt of a referral or complaint from the Department of Industrial Relations' Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS). Labor Code Section 3099.2 stipulates that anyone who performs work as an electrician for C-10 Electrical contractors shall hold an electrical certification card issued by DAS; DAS is required by Labor Code Section 3099.2 to report violations to CSLB. 


